For men, friendship is usually based on doing things together, not the intimate conversations that are typical of women friends. Men share activities like building a fence or a business, running, riding a bike or watching football, but **they** don't often share their feelings.

Although many women find **their** relationships with a husband is not enough, many men say that their partner is their best friend. There is, in fact, more and more evidence that having friends protects us against illness and depression. The uninhibited laughter that is typical of many friendships reduces the effects of stress and helps the immune system work properly. Lasting
